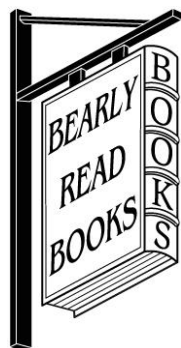


Happy Valentine's Day

Casa Guidi Windows and Other Poems

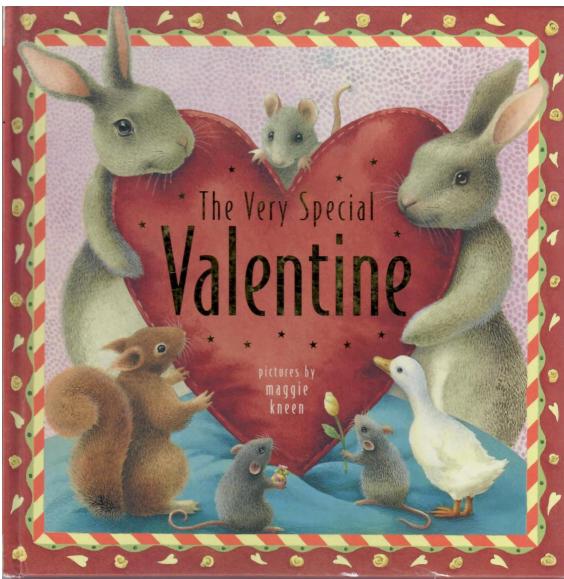
by Elizabeth Barrett Browning \$250.

Browning's *Casa Guidi Window* is a two-part poem about the Italian struggle to end Austrian domination. Part One is a commentary on the hopeful early events in Italy's struggle for political autonomy and unification. Part Two was written

two or three years later. This is her eye-witness view of history from the windows of Casa Guidi, her new home in Florence.

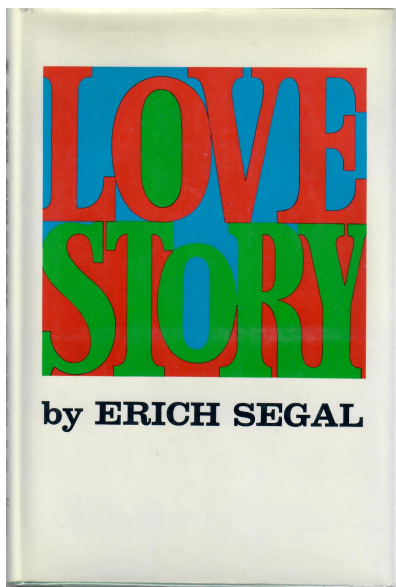


Little Journeys to the Homes of Great Lovers
