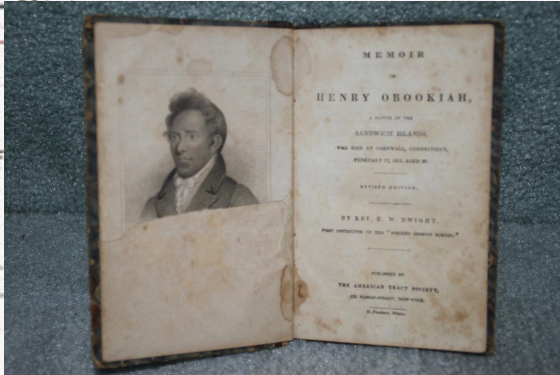

Some Interesting Finds...



Memoir of Henry Obookiah, A Native of the Sandwich Islands, who died at Cornwall, Connecticut, February 17, 1818, Aged 26

By Reverend Edwin W. Dwight, Published by The American Tract Society Revised edition.

Obookia was a native of the Sandwich Islands and is credited as the catalyst for the Islands' conversion to Christianity. This book tells his remarkable story of his early years in Hawaii and his move to Massachusetts and then to Connecticut through first-hand accounts, letters and his diary. Besides translating the Book of Genesis into Hawaiian, Obookiah had nearly completed a Hawaiian dictionary, grammar, and spelling book before his untimely death at the age of 26.

This copy is the revised edition published shortly after 1818.

Marbled boards, rubbed and bumped. Spine is rubbed. Title and bands in gilt on spine. Gift inscription dated 1848 on FFEP, otherwise undated. Binding tight. Endpapers are foxed as well as most pages throughout. Frontis is torn and lacking bottom half, otherwise complete. \$95



Gone With The Wind

Margaret Mitchell

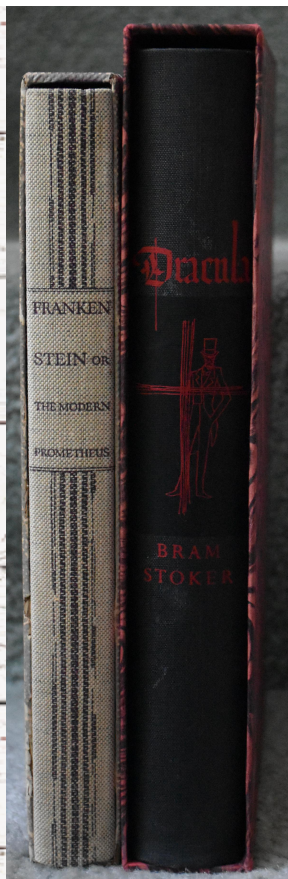
There were only 10,000 copies of the first edition of *Gone With the Wind* printed. The copyright page has an incorrect release date of May, 1936. The second printing of 25,000 copies states June 1936, with no indication of the May date.

A Book Club Edition (BCE) was printed and released at the same time as the first and second printings, which causes confusion for new collectors, but they remain one of the few BCEs that still have some value. One indicator of the BCE is roman numerals for 1936 (MCMXXXVI) on the copyright page.

We have several copies in stock from second printing, a BCE and a two volume illustrated edition ranging from \$25-\$250.
